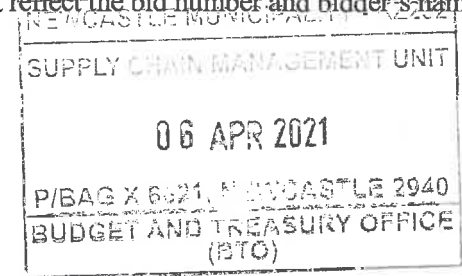

Local Production and Content Requirements

This bid will be evaluated for Local Production and Content. Only bids that achieve the minimum stipulated threshold for local production and content may be evaluated further. The stipulated threshold percentages for local production and content for Furniture Products is 85%.

The Declaration Certificate for Local Production and Content (MBD6.2) together with Annex C (Local Content Declaration Summary Schedule) must be completed, duly signed and submitted by the bidder at the closing date and time of the bid, and

In accordance with new Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 clause 4(1)(a),

- (i) tenderers must be an Exempt Micro Enterprise (EME).
- (ii) the rates of exchange quoted by the bidder in paragraph 4.1 of the Declaration Certificate will be verified for accuracy.
- (iii) $LC = (1 - x/y) * 100$

Where

X = is the imported content in Rand

Y = is the bid price in Rand excluding value added tax (VAT)

Price referred to in the determination of x must be converted to Rand (ZAR) by using the exchange rate published by the SARB at 12:00 on the date of advertisement of the bid.

Bids will be adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 pertaining to Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 5/2000 and other applicable legislations and other applicable legislations, and will be based on 80/20 points system. Preference points will be awarded to service providers using their B-BBEE status level of contribution. The bids will remain valid for 90 days. The Council reserves the right to accept all, some, or none of the bids submitted, either wholly or in part and it is not obliged to accept the lowest bid.

Completed bids in plain sealed envelopes, endorsed "**Bid number and description**" bearing the name, address and bidder's contact details at the back of the envelope should be placed in the bid box provided at the Municipal Civic Centre (Tower Block 1st Floor Rates hall) in 37 Murchison Street, Newcastle by no later than 12:00pm of the closing date where bids will be opened in public.
